The Community Art Workshop (CAW) is a mentoring program for young women and youth. In our program students work with a professional artist and learn about the visual arts, fiber arts, quilting, knitting, crochet and jewelry making. The goal of our program is to build self-esteem, pride and confidence in youth through learning a skill that they can enjoy and use throughout their lives. Young women between the ages of 10-18 years are eligible to participate in the program. As participants advance they can become mentors, too and share what they've learned with other youth like themselves. Participating in the CAW mentoring program an exciting opportunity to learn a skill that can grow into a viable practice, career, even a business.
